- 01. Criteria for Awarding Gold Medal for Overall Highest FGPA - “Prof. Aruni Weerasinghe Gold Medal”**
  - The Student should possess the highest FGPA and at least with 2<sup>nd</sup> class upper division.
  - The Student should pass all the subjects at the 01<sup>st</sup> attempt.
  - The Student should have maintained a good discipline within his/her academic period.
  
- 02. Criteria for Awarding Gold Medal for Highest GPA in Core Courses - “Sisu Udana Gold Medal”**
  - The Student should possess the highest GPA in Core courses (from semester 1 to semester 5).
  - The Student should pass all the subjects at the 01<sup>st</sup> attempt.
  - The Student should have maintained a good discipline within his/her academic period.
